Re: Update on Enhanced COVID Protocols

Hello Friends,

In light of the surge in New Coronavirus Cases in Pennsylvania, as reported by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, we have determined it is prudent to extend our previously announced closures to December 4, 2020.

In October, there were less than 1,000 new cases a day. This week alone there are more than 6,000. Because of this six-fold increase we need to change our procedure again.

- There will be no food pantry pick-ups Monday, November 23 through Friday, December 4, 2020.

As previously posted, through the New Year we will also continue adhere to the following:

- All doors will be locked, entry will only be possible through the front door
- All pickups and deliveries must be contactless only
- After December 4, all food pantry pick-ups will take place outside only
- No walk-in volunteers will be permitted on the premises, please call our office to register as a volunteer in advance at 215-464-2224
- Food pick-ups for senior client friends will occur one-at-a-time. Please ring bell at front door.
- We will continue to adhere to CDC guidelines as we have been since the beginning of the outbreak including requiring masks to be worn by all on premises, enhanced handwashing, sanitization etc.
